INVITES high school educators/groups and their First Nation, Inuit & Metis students to attend Dreamspeakers Youth Day 2017 at **Boyle Street Community League**, 9538 103A Avenue Street in Edmonton, Alberta on Thursday, September 21 from 9am to 3 pm. Participants will gain knowledge of **'Get Youth Involved! - Making a Film'**. As we kick off a new approach to teaching youth how the film industry works, we want youth to participate in our *Dreamspeakers Promo Project* to help us reach a larger audience for social media. We will film the day, teach you how to make a film and film it. **Please join us in making this happen!**

Registration Guidelines

Who can Attend: Indigenous students Grades 7-12 and their chaperones are invited to Youth Day. As well as, mature students up to the age of 21. Space is limited. **Registration is on a first come first serve basis.**

Registration: Admission is \$50. There are no limits for the number of youth/students that your school organization can register, however, you may not exceed the confirmed number of registered students on the day of the event.

The chaperone, an accompanying adult (ie. Teacher, education/guidance counselor or parent) must pre-register all students in their group and will be responsible for obtaining parental permission for each youth prior to attending Youth Day. **Participant release forms will be provided when registered*

Chaperones: Are responsible for ensuring proper student supervision, discipline and be accountable for their students at all times during entire day. It is recommended one chaperone accompany 5-10 students. Chaperone can be requested/arranged if registering under 4 youth. Chaperones are expected to check in at registration table upon arrival. Check in time is 8 am.

Youth Day Participation

Youth and chaperones are encouraged to actively participate in the youth day event so they can benefit from what is presented.

Travel/Parking: Registration does not included travel or transportation costs.

*** Lunch is provided.**

Cancellation/Change: In the event a registered youth or chaperone is no longer able to attend the school/group may provide substitutes but must notify in writing via email or fax. If your school/group is cancelling, please notify Dreamspeakers immediately so we can make that space available.

Deadline Date: You will be emailed a confirmation of registration **on or before September 18, 2017.**
